### **Daylight Saving Time Ends**

Be prepared to “fall back” early Sunday morning, as people across North America gain an hour of sleep with the end of daylight saving time. The switch happens at 2 am local daylight time. Most devices connected wirelessly to the Internet will automatically “fall back” to 1 am local standard time, but don't forget to change any clocks that need a manual change, such as a wall or microwave clock.

Windsor Fire & Rescue Services is recommending residents install new batteries in their smoke and carbon monoxide alarms when they change their clocks. In order to survive a fire, you need to be provided with an early warning and know what to do when the smoke alarms sound. It's the law to have working smoke alarms on every storey of the home and outside all sleeping areas. Carbon monoxide alarms must be installed outside all sleeping areas if your home has a fuel-burning appliance, fireplace or attached garage.

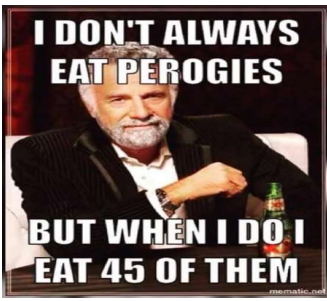

**Full Beaver Moon**

This Full Moon will appear as the largest and **brightest** Moon in the sky since 1948! November's Full Moon is a "Perigee" Moon – when the Moon reaches the point in its orbit that is closest to Earth. This is popularly called a "Supermoon". In addition, this Perigee Moon will also be nearer to earth than it's been since January 26, 1948. While the Moon won't technically be getting any bigger, it will appear up to 14% larger than when it is at its furthest point. This full Moon is not only the closest full Moon of 2016 but also the closest full Moon to date in the 21<sup>st</sup> century and it won't come this close to Earth again until November 25, 2034.

November's full Moon was called the Beaver Moon by both the colonists and the Algonquin tribes because this was the time to set beaver traps before the swamps froze, to ensure a supply of warm, winter furs.

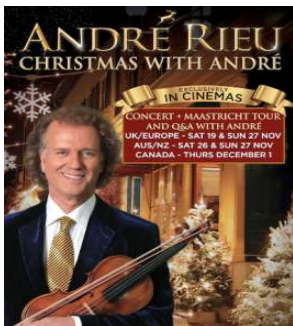
